

### Q2 Are you male or female?





# Q5 Remembering the stay in hospital for your Ileal Conduit surgery only, for how many days were you hospitalized?









## Q8 After your Ileal Conduit surgery, how would you describe your sleep patterns, with the addition of a urinary collection bag?





### Q9 Do you ever have a stoma blockage?







### Q12 Have you had any changes in your bowel function since surgery?





# Q13 Do you regularly use any medications now, to assist with satisfactory bowel movements, that you DID NOT regularly use before surgery?




### Q14 How happy are you with your Ileal conduit?




### Q15 How happy are you with your decision to have a Ileal Conduit?




### Q16 Since your Ileal Conduit Surgery, have you been able to attain any level of natural erection?



## Q17 Since your Ileal Conduit Surgery, have you been able to attain any level of erection using pharmaceuticals?


