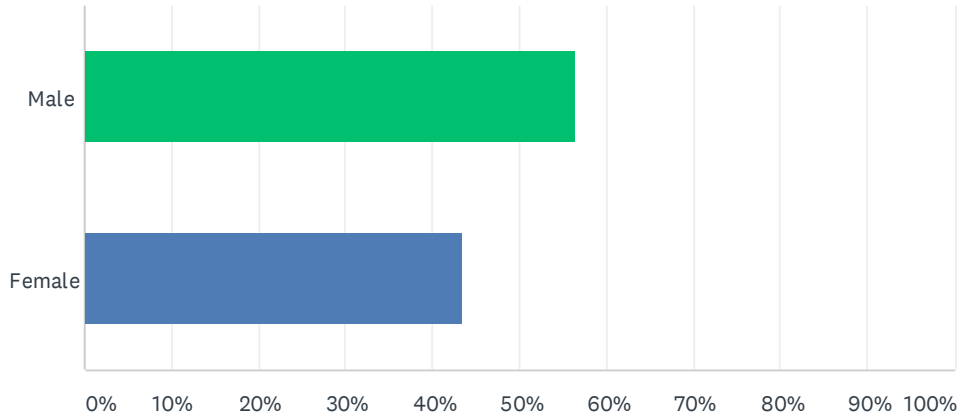


Q2 Are you male or female?

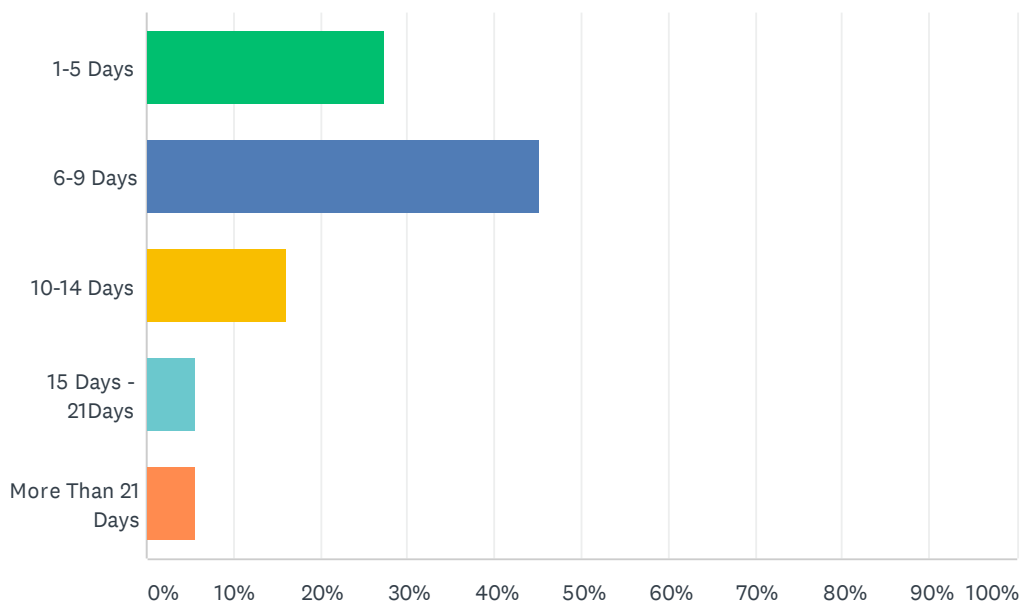

Q5 Remembering the stay in hospital for your Ileal Conduit surgery only, for how many days were you hospitalized?

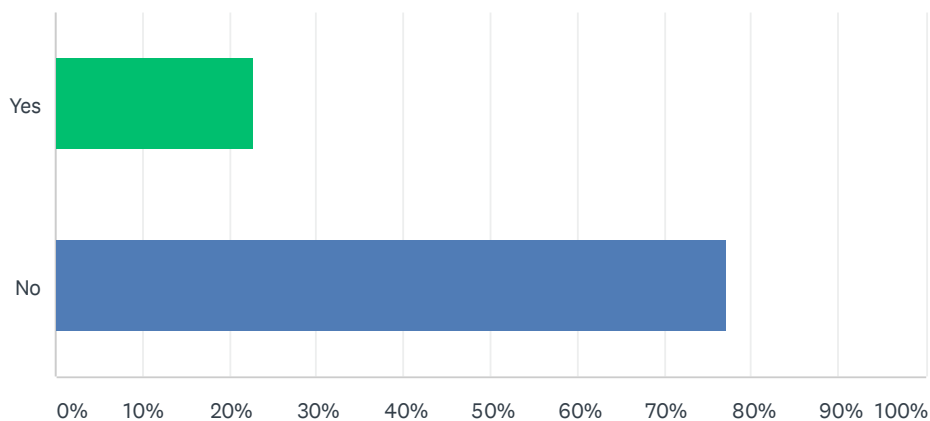

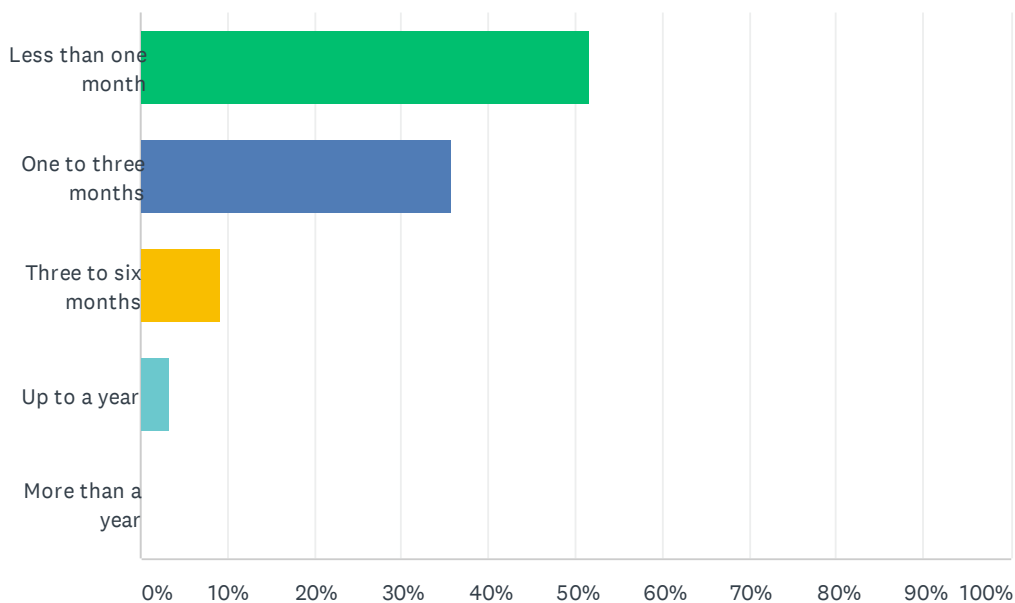

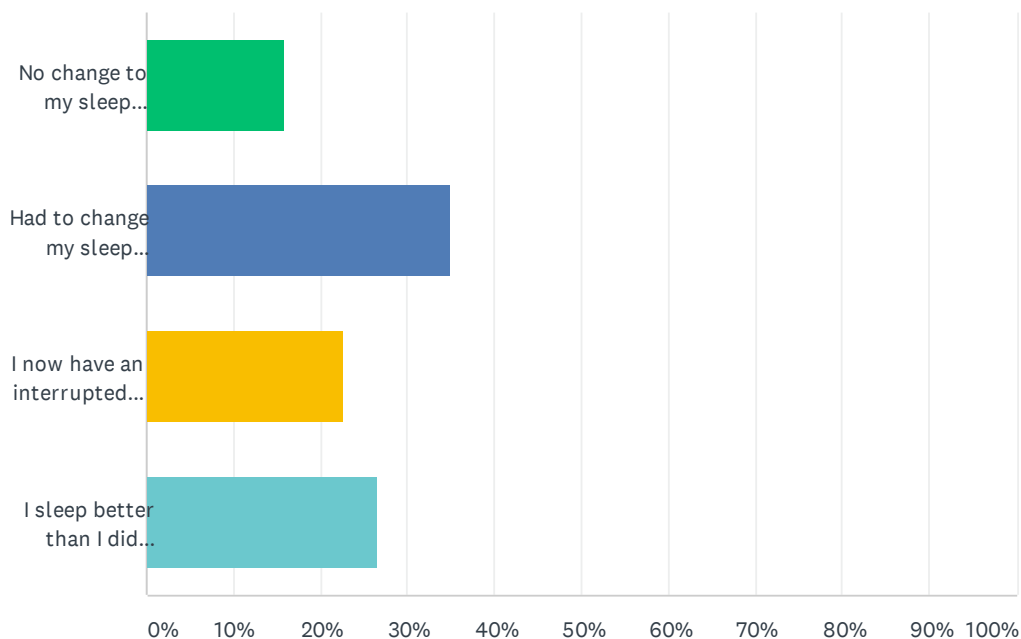

Q8 After your Ileal Conduit surgery, how would you describe your sleep patterns, with the addition of a urinary collection bag?

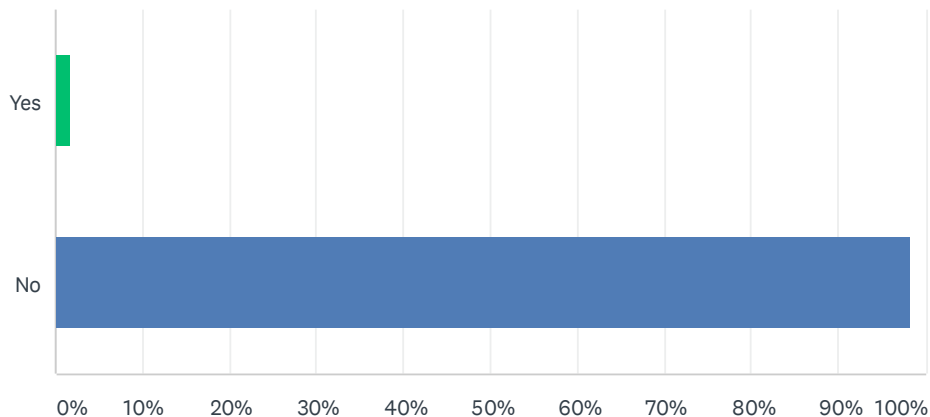

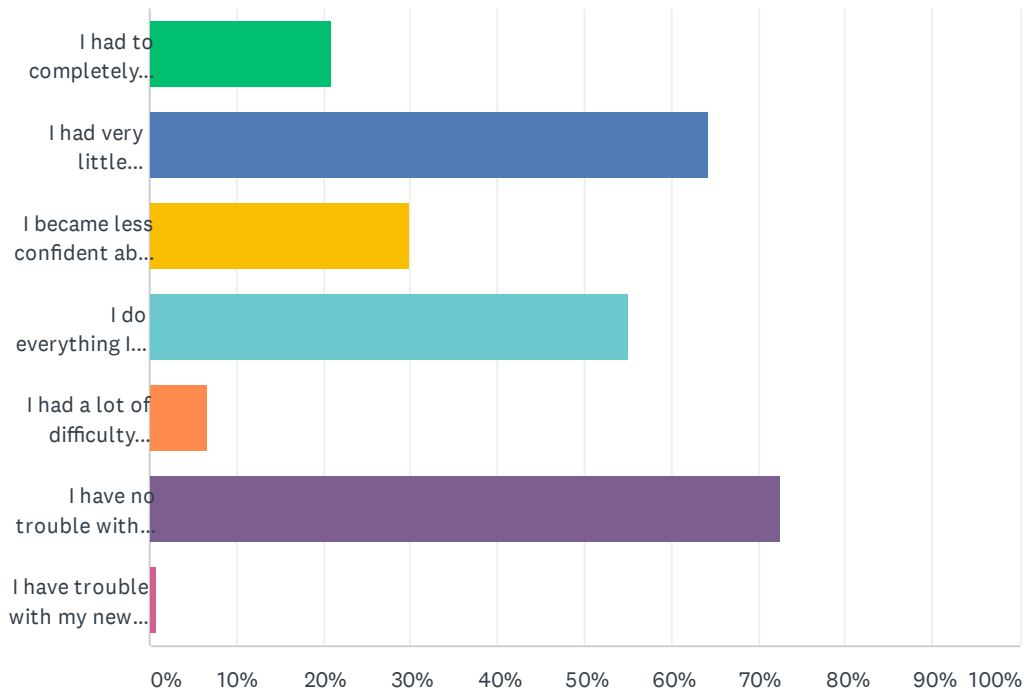

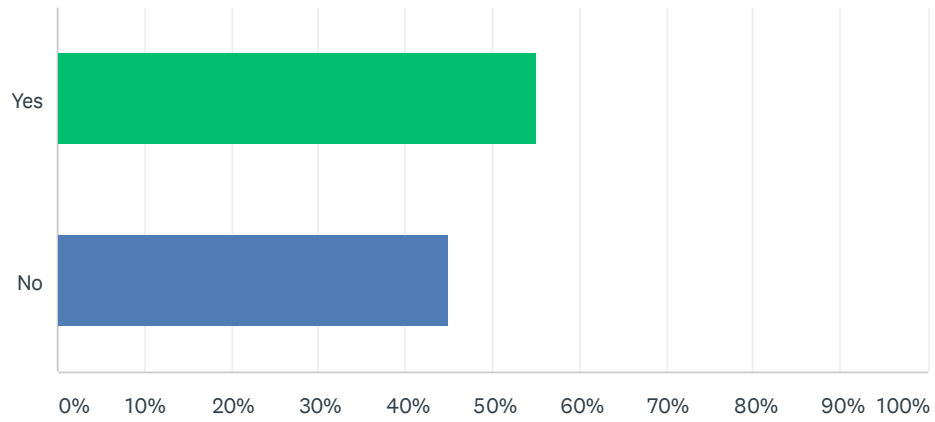

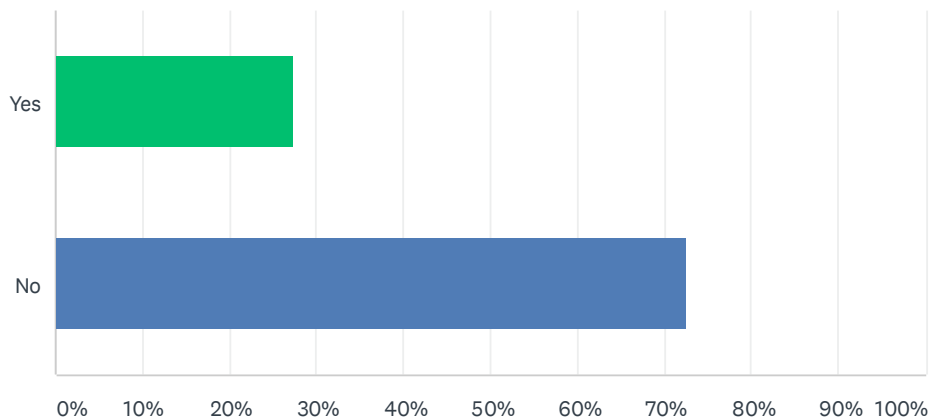

Q13 Do you regularly use any medications now, to assist with satisfactory bowel movements, that you DID NOT regularly use before surgery?

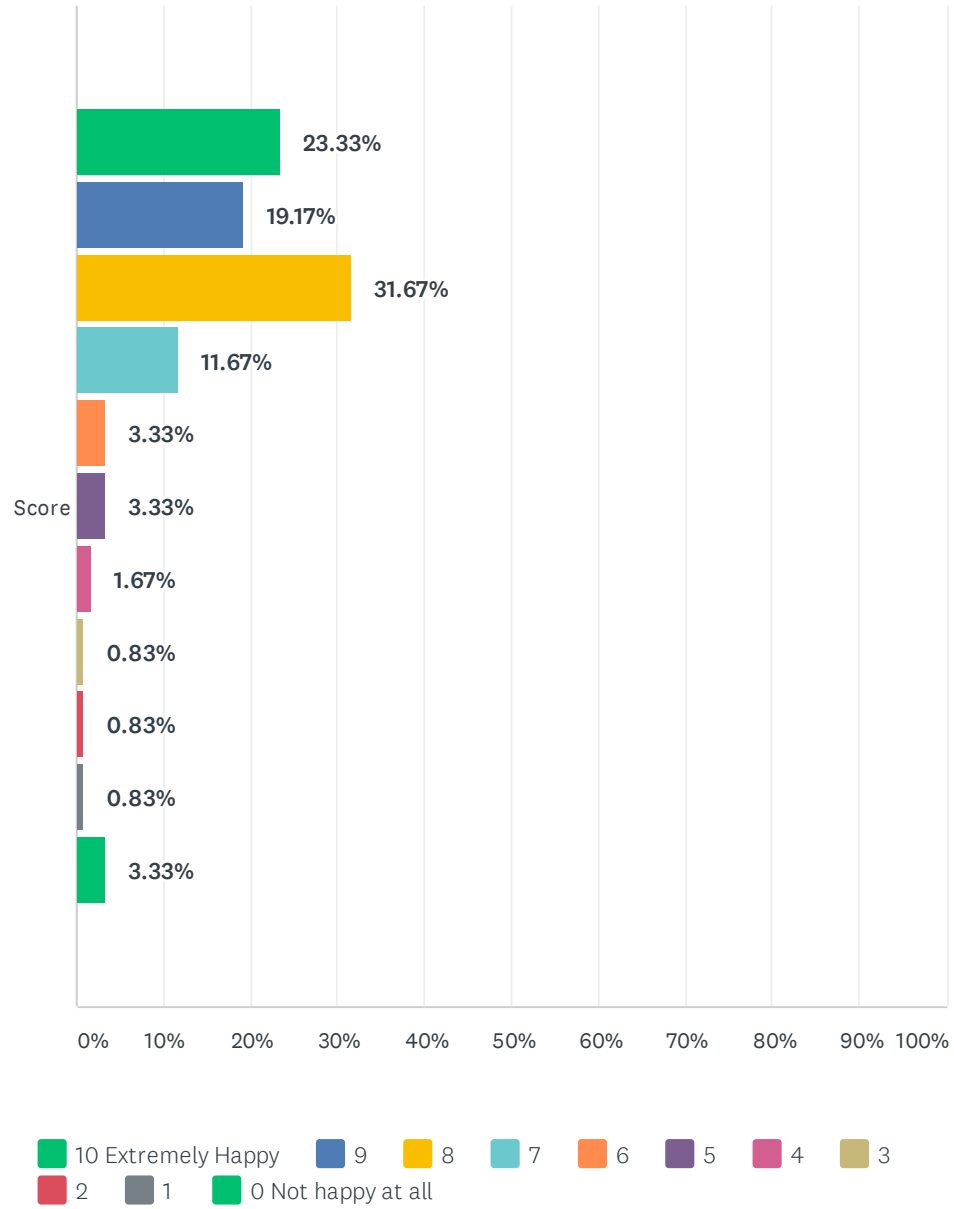

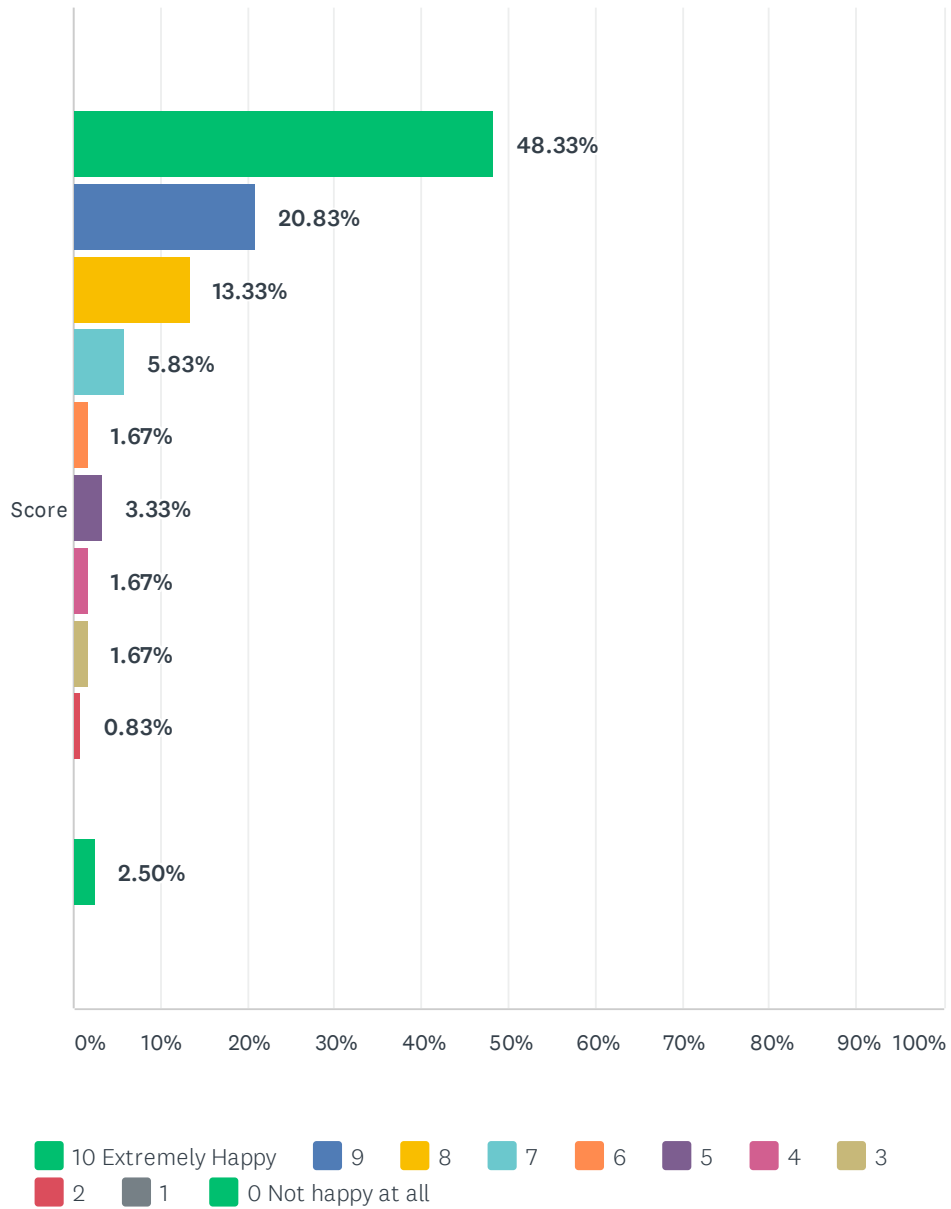
Q14 How happy are you with your Ileal conduit?

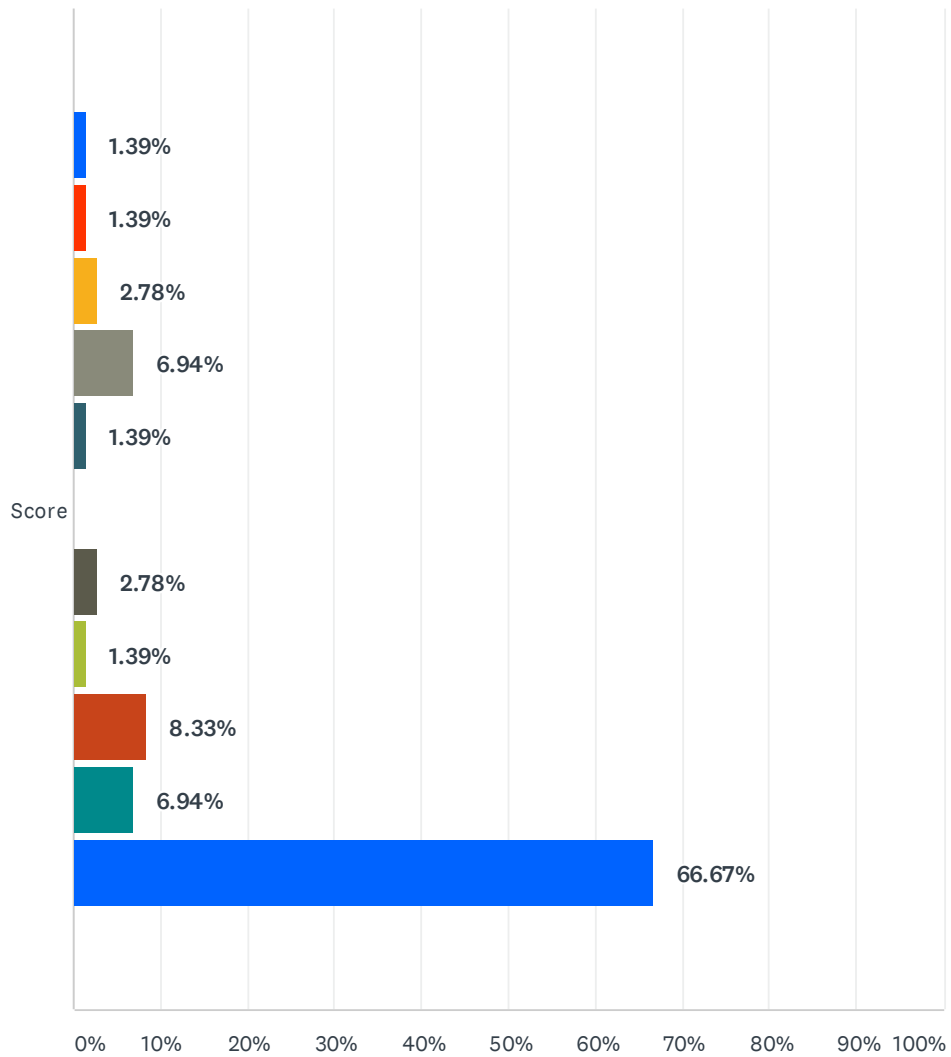
Q15 How happy are you with your decision to have a Ileal Conduit?

Q16 Since your Ileal Conduit Surgery, have you been able to attain any level of natural erection?

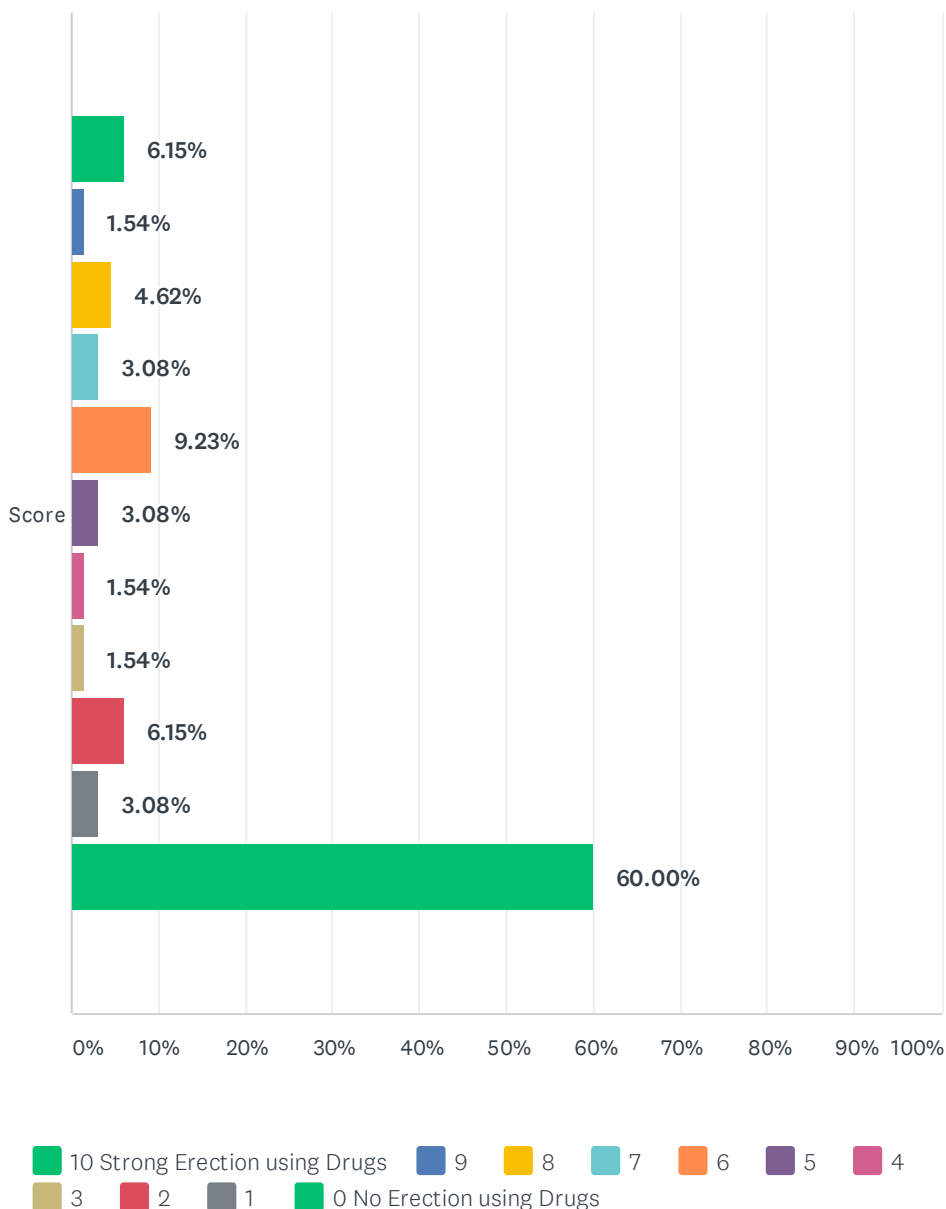

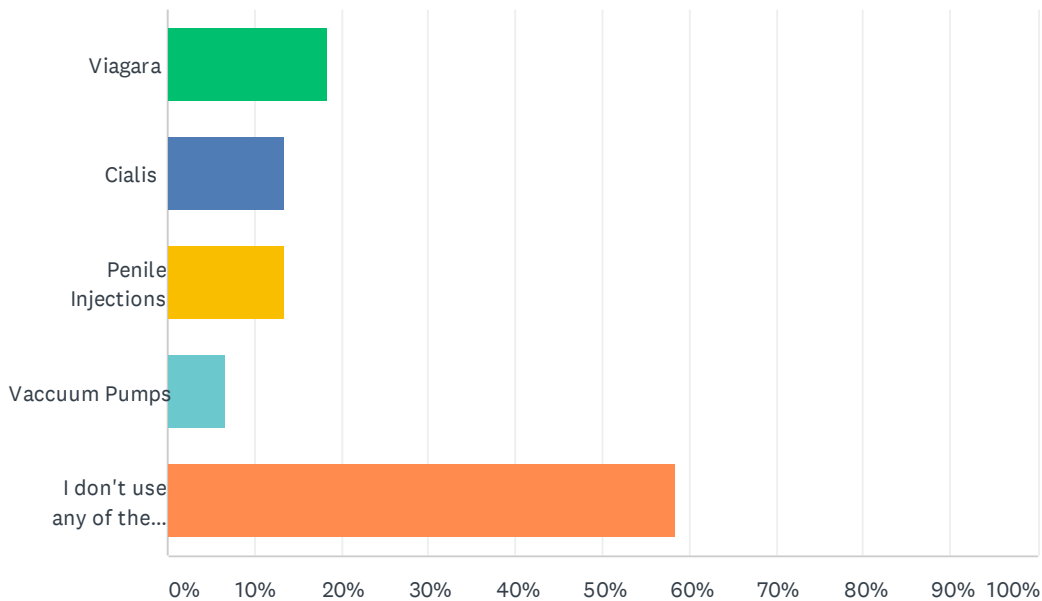
Q17 Since your Ileal Conduit Surgery, have you been able to attain any level of erection using pharmaceuticals?

Q18 Which prescription medications work best for you to gain an erection?

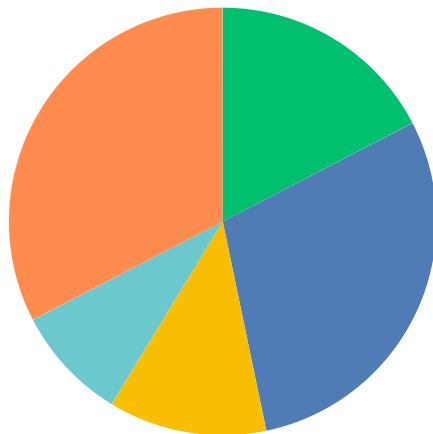
